BLOCK AREA

When a child works in the Block Area, he/she:

- \Rightarrow learns to use imagination to create something from his/her own thinking.
- \rightarrow has the satisfaction of being able to make something.
- learns about sizes and shapes, weights and balances, height and depth, smoothness, roughness and volume.
- → is exercising his/her body.
- 🛏 may be learning to play with others.
- learns to communicate ideas through language when discussing similarities and differences.
- 🛏 learns to solve problems an make decisions.
- 🗢 creates patterns when building.
- represents personal experiences through role play and pretending.

You can help as a volunteer by:

- building with the children and talking with them about that what you are building together.
- → watching the children and what they are creating.
- → showing the children how to build as high as their shoulders.
- demonstrating the correct way to ask someone to share a block that you need in your building.
- reminding, showing and helping the children put away at clean-up time. Each block has it's own place to be stored.
- 🗢 counting blocks with the children.
- comparing size and shapes of different blocks.
